Palm Sunday began with the blessing of pussy willows at Vespers on Saturday, April 8, 2023, and draping the church furnishings with green cloths.



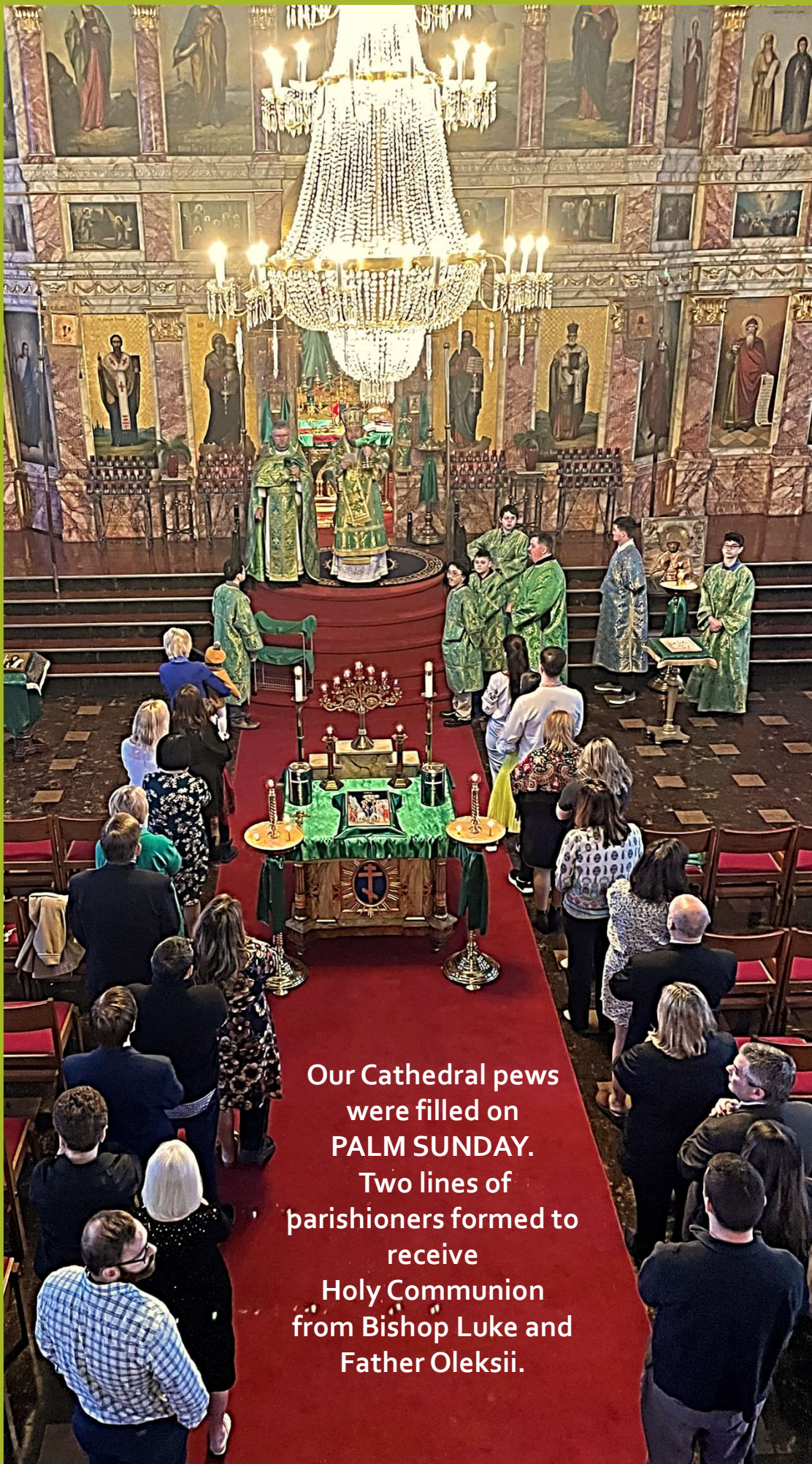

On the Feast Day of Palm Sunday, a joyful Bishop Luke blessed the congregation with Holy Water.



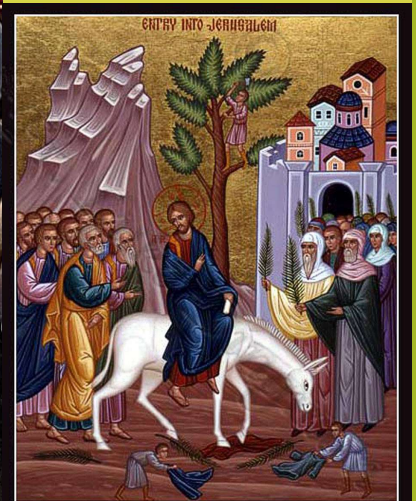


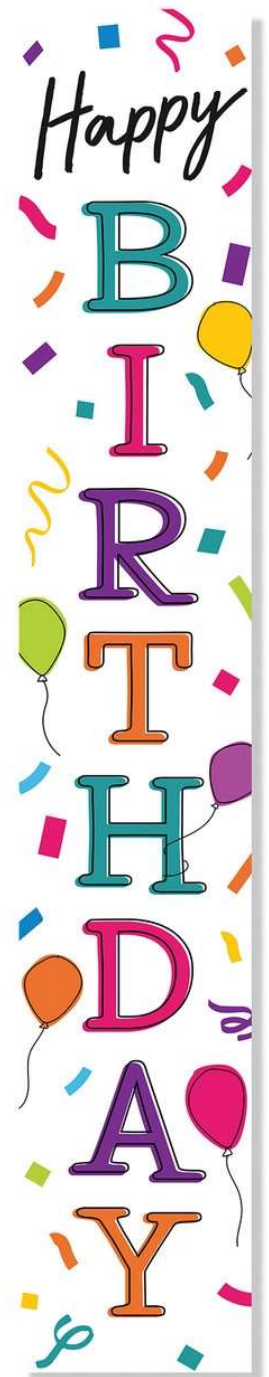

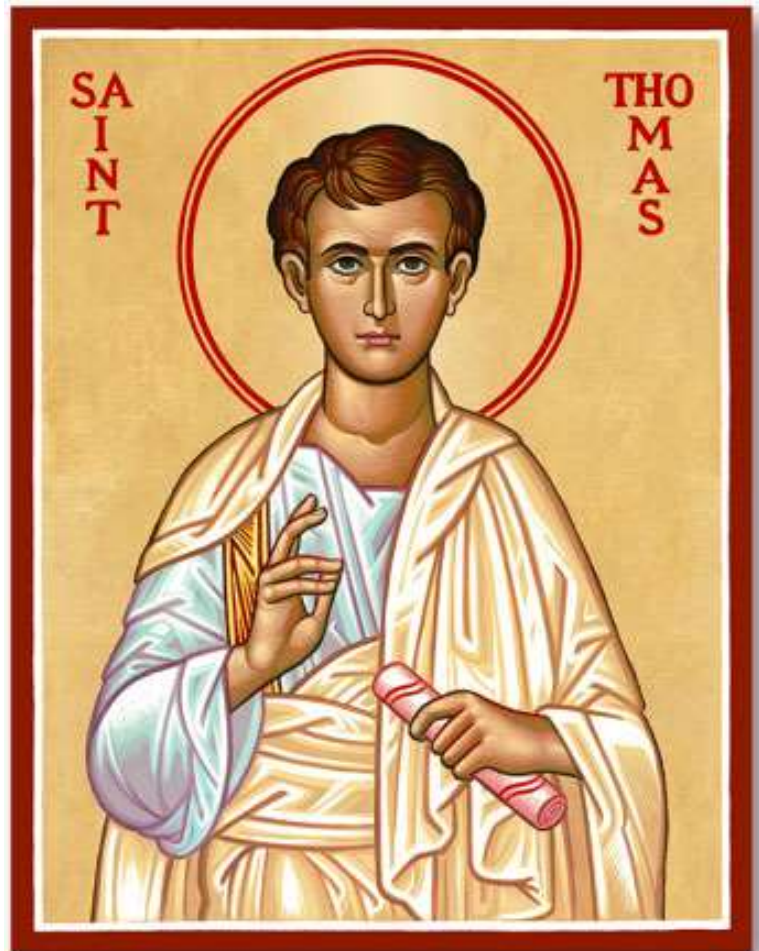

A variety of seasonal, potted, flowering Easter plants will decorate the Tomb. For a donation of \$15, you can take **THREE** plants home after Divine Liturgy on Bright Monday, April 17.



REMINDER: Our oil votives must be lit with a clicker lighter. If you try to use the flame from a candle to light the oil votive, you will damage the votive by clogging the wick with dripping wax, and the votive can no longer be used.

And being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, "which," He said, "you have heard from Me; for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now. Therefore, when they had come together, they asked Him, saying, "Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?" And He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority. John bore witness of Him and cried out, saying, "This was He of whom I said, 'He who comes after me is preferred before me, for He was before me.' " And of His fullness we have all received, and grace for grace. For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.. **(John 1:1-17)**

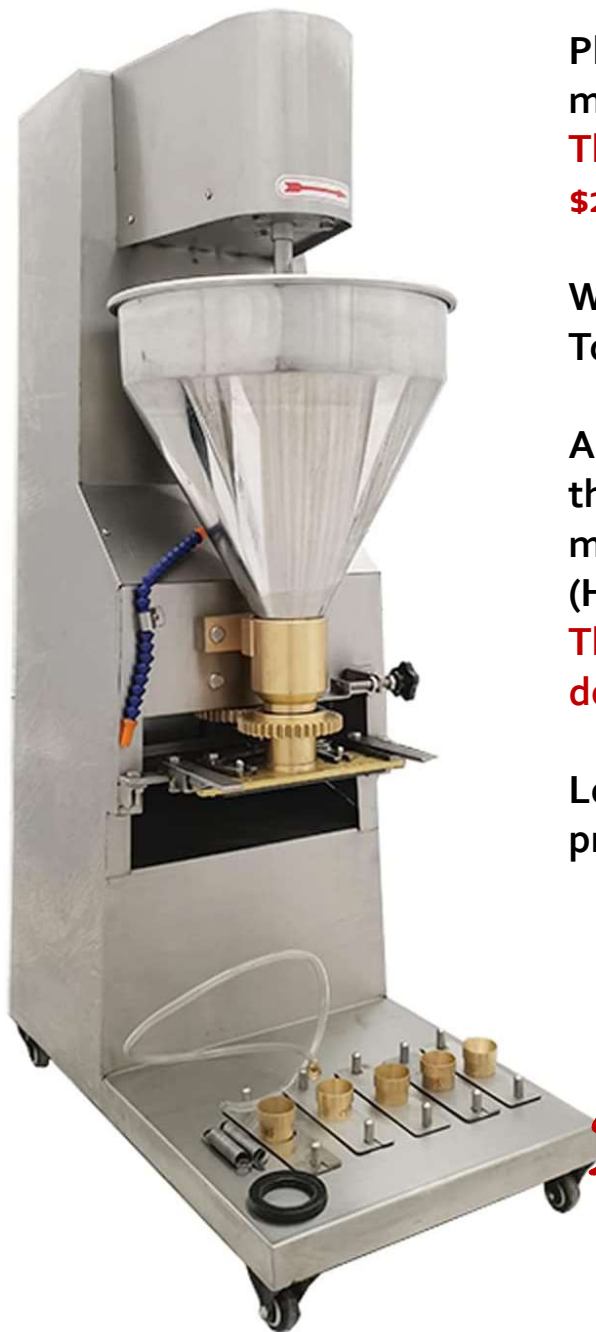

Judy Hanney, Festival Director, is always looking for ways to improve pierogi production. The Omcan Dough Sheeter and Hobart Mixer were wise investments in 2021 and proved to be great time savers. Generous donations from the Hall Fund (\$7,199.00), the Sisterhood (\$3,000.00), Judy and Tom Hanney (\$1,000.00) and Susan Guz (\$1,000.00) paid for the machines. Now we are planning to purchase a commercial meatball-forming machine. Anyone who has spent hours during Festival food prep in past years knows what a tedious, time-consuming job it is to scoop the potato-cheese filling into uniformly sized balls. This machine could be used for the filling, potentially cutting our current production time in half.
