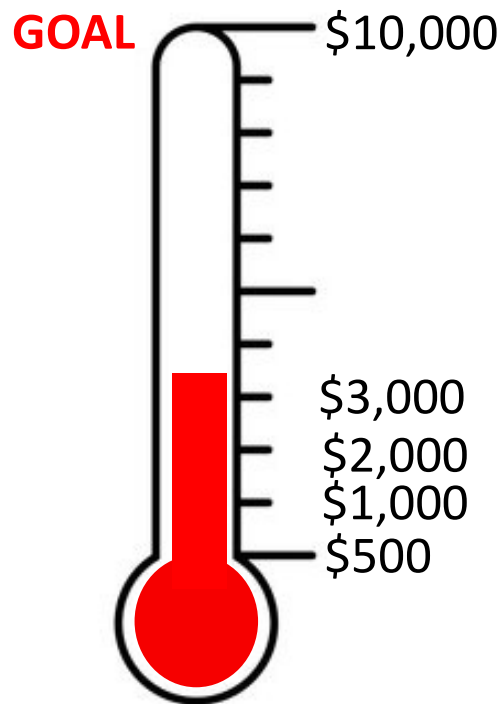


EXTERIOR PAINTING FUND-RAISING CAMPAIGN

He who descended is also the One who ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.)
