Scripture Reading & Sermon
Sunday, January 7, 2024
Matthew 2:1-12

There are so many things to ponder in Sunday's Scripture reading: Angels announcing the birth of Jesus to the shepherds, the wise men – the Magi – on their long journey to find the baby, asking Herod for directions, following the star, bringing gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh. And the birth of Jesus, hailed a king and worshipped by the wise men and shepherds – but not by everyone in Bethlehem!

Those who truly worship Jesus will faithfully tell others about Him -- just as the Magi and shepherds did. And there are those who hear about the miracle and ignore it, going on with their lives. ***Building Up...*THE BUILDING FUND**

The Building Fund has been in our Bulletin news frequently over the past few months. We have directed donations from some Fellowship Lunches, special events and Boutique sales to the Building Fund. Why?

We are planning to change the acoustical ceiling tiles in the Cathedral Hall a/k/a Liberty North Hall. Our existing tiles – and lights – are old, scarred, and dated. Together they give the impression of a stark community room – rather than an elegant banquet hall.

After discussions with some parishioners and the Council, swapping out our old tiles and upgrading them with new vinyl, coffered tiles, as well as installing LED “high hat” lighting, will change the “look” of the Hall, permitting us to increase the Hall rental fee. Hall rentals are the Cathedral’s #1 revenue source. We need to not only maintain the Hall but upgrade it periodically to maximize returns.

The Hall will be closed for rentals in September and October 2024 for the sole purpose of completing this project. We will devise a schedule and ask for volunteers to help take out the old tiles and put in the new tiles. Samples of the new ceiling tiles have been installed in the Office. Stop by and take a peek!
