Father Bohdan's Sermon – Sunday, June 14, 2020 Matthew 10:32-33; 37-38; 19:27-30

Today's Bible reading is short – and its message is very clear: WHAT IS YOUR REWARD FOR FOLLOWING CHRIST? The answer is: ETERNAL LIFE. Eternity in God's presence. Eternity in God's family. Today we commemorate all the extraordinary saints who gave up everything to follow Jesus. They gave up their families, jobs and possessions to follow Christ and preach His teachings, with the promise of eternal life. Must YOU give up everything? All the Church asks of you is to give up your TIME to follow Christ – just 1 hour on a Sunday morning! And then devote time to doing good work in the Church. As you know, there is no end to the work that is needed in the Church. I know there are faithful, dedicated people in our church family who organize, cook, comfort, teach, pray, preach, clean, sing and more. The work is just waiting for true followers of Christ to step up and say "HERE I AM, LORD. PUT ME TO WORK. I AM NOT HERE FOR A FREE RIDE." Can we then call you a saint for doing such work for the Church? NO. Only God will judge you. That what is meant by the words in today's Scripture reading: Many who are first will be last, and many who are last will be first. AMEN.



What is a MOLEBEN?


A Moleben is a prayer service of intercession, supplication or thanksgiving asking Jesus Christ, the Holy Theotokos or one of the saints for assistance. Molebens may be served for a specific need, e.g., for someone who is ill; prior to surgery or travel; in commemoration of an event, such as the beginning of the New Year, or when students graduate or start a school term; or a Moleben may be devotional, in honor of a particular saint.



On Sunday, June 14, two Molebens were served for two St. Nicholas Parishioners – *on opposite sides of the world!*


Julia Borriello, daughter of Christopher


