Blessing of Pussy Willows following Vespers on Saturday, April 24, 2021





The 500 blessed pussy willow stems were given to parishioners who attended Divine Liturgy on Palm Sunday the next day.

Today we celebrate the first Palm Sunday when

Father Bohdan's Sermon John 12:1-18

Jesus was hailed as the Messiah as He entered Jerusalem and palm branches were laid at His feet. Tomorrow is the start of Holy Week and a lot happens within a short period of time. How fickle we are! Sometimes we are like a weathervane. pointing in one direction and then in another. Look at the crowds who came to glorify Jesus today in Jerusalem! "Hosanna!," they shout. "Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! The King of Israel!" Jesus shares a Last Supper with His apostles - and then is betrayed. Jesus forgives us and then we scream to the Romans CRUCIFY HIM! All this happens within one week. Yes, there are those who remain true, steadfast, and confident in their devotion - even when the going gets tough. And during this Holy Week, as each day leads up to the Resurrection, it will be a difficult journey....especially Good Friday, which is not good at all. Jesus, after His long walk carrying the cross on His back, is crucified and dies. We mourn on this day. Some of us quit, some follow what the crowd does, some remain faithful despite terrible circumstances. What kind of person are YOU? People love, hate and are indifferent to Jesus. Are you faithful like Mary and Martha - or are you a quitter like Judas? As your priest, I know the answer. You are here today, you are reverent, you are pious, you sacrifice, you change your priorities in life to be of service to your church and your faith. You believe and wait for the resurrection on Sunday, Pascha, as we celebrate Jesus' triumph over death! In your daily life, reflect upon the human qualities of the disciples and the people in Jesus' life - and death. Put yourself in their places. Today, imagine yourself watching Jesus enter Jerusalem on the donkey. You know His fate - but you also know yours. We rejoice today - but will cry later in the week - and then we will REJOICE AGAIN on Easter! AMEN.

READER: Brothers...The former account I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach, until the day in which He was taken up, after He through the Holy Spirit had given commandments to the apostles whom He had chosen, to whom He also presented Himself alive after His suffering by many infallible proofs, being seen by them during forty days and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God. And being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, "which," He said, "you have heard from Me; for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now. Therefore, when they had come together, they asked Him, saying, "Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?" And He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority. But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth. (Acts 1:1-8)

PRIEST: The reading from the Holy Gospel according to Saint John.

CHOIR: Glory to Thee, O Lord, glory to Thee.

PRIEST: Let us attend. In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it. There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. This man came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all through him might believe. He was not that Light, but was sent to bear witness of that Light. That was the true Light which gives light to every man coming into the world. He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. John bore witness of Him and cried out, saying, "This was He of whom I said, 'He who comes after me is preferred before me, for He was before me.' "And of His fullness we have all received, and grace for grace. For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.. (John 1:1-17)


